Our Common Home - Holy Island Pilgrimage

Climate change destroys God's precious gift to us - creation. This point was firmly made at the brilliant Storey Lecture last weekend by Professor Paul Rogers, Emeritus Professor of Peace Studies at Bradford University and Global Security Consultant with the Oxford Research Group. Climate change, political unrest and economics are all linked. This will be the theme of this year's CAFOD Pilgrimage to Holy Island on Saturday 22nd June.
