Blessed John Henry Newman to be Canonised

It has been announced that Pope Francis will canonise Blessed John Henry Newman in St Peter's, Rome, on Sunday 13th October 2019 alongside four others. This will make Cardinal Newman the first English person who has lived since the 17th century officially recognised as a saint by the Roman Catholic Church.

Extraordinary Month of Mission

Pope Francis has called the whole Church to observe an Extraordinary Month of Mission (EMM) this October. It is, in the Holy Father's words, *"a wonderful opportunity to reflect upon and recommit ourselves to missio ad gentes; that most important element of mission that focuses on bringing the Gospel to those who have not yet heard it"*.

The work of Missio is promoting mission to the nations, supporting the Church where it is too poor or too young to support itself, training local clergy, religious and catechists, and helping children in need.

The Church in Mongolia is only 27 years old and began with three missionaries, who were later joined by Sisters from South Korea, Bangladesh, France, Italy and Democratic Republic of Congo. In 2017 the first Mongolian priest, Fr Joseph, was ordained.

Children's Liturgy

A reminder that the Children's Liturgy is intended for children who are aged four and over. Generally they continue to be a part of the group for one year after their First Holy Communion, and after this they should be ready to remain with their families during the Liturgy of the Word. We use a simpler form of the readings of the Sunday, but children younger than four are not yet able to understand and contribute to the group. Children should be confident enough to attend without a parent, although you are very welcome to take them in for the first time. DBS checked
