Extraordinary Month of Mission

Pope Francis has called the whole Church to observe an Extraordinary Month of Mission (EMM) this October. Pope Francis asks schools, parishes, organisations, orders, dioceses, communities and individuals to support this global initiative. During October, the Holy Father invites everyone to join in the EMM2019 Universal Prayer Chain, in solidarity and love for all people. EMM is not replacing Mission Sunday, they are separate but complimentary events. On World Mission Sunday, 20th October, the theme is **'Together we are Mission'**, and we shall still be having the obligatory collection for Overseas Missions.

Caritas World Day of the Poor Celebration

Parishioners, volunteers, charity workers and service users are invited for a unique celebration of Catholic Social Action in our Diocese on Saturday 16th November at St Mary's Cathedral in Middlesbrough. There will be speakers, displays, liturgy, drama and music.
