**World Mission Sunday** On the second last Sunday of October, World Mission Sunday is celebrated in all parishes throughout the world.

12 million children are victims of child trafficking and child labour. Five year old Vandoosha was sold by her family to be a domestic worker and Shorti was stolen at a very young age and does not even know what her parents named her or how old she is. Shorti was put to work begging at a busy station. These two young girls, seen on the poster, were rescued by Sr Clara and taken back to the convent at Marialaya where they received education, medical care, counselling and spiritual formation and they now face a bright future. Today's Retiring Collection for Missio will go towards the rescue of many other children
