### **Extraordinary Month of Mission**

Pope Francis has called the whole Church to observe an Extraordinary Month of Mission (EMM) this October. It is, in the Holy Father's words, *"a wonderful opportunity to reflect upon and recommit ourselves to missio ad gentes; that most important element of mission that focuses on bringing the Gospel to those who have not yet heard it"*.

The work of Missio (formerly Mill Hill and APF Red Boxes) is promoting mission to the nations, supporting the Church where it is too poor or too young to support itself, training local clergy, religious and catechists, and helping children in need.

Fr Anthony Chowdry, National Director of Missio, has sent copies for everyone of the Missio Magazine, which red box holders receive each quarter. Pope Francis asks schools, parishes, organisations, orders, dioceses, communities and individuals to support this global initiative. During October, the Holy Father invites everyone to join in the EMM2019 Universal Prayer Chain, in solidarity and love for all people.

EMM is not replacing Mission Sunday, they are separate but complimentary events. On

World Mission Sunday, 20th October, the theme is **‘Together we are Mission’**, and we shall still be having the obligatory collection for Overseas Missions. The following Sunday, 27th October, Fr Frank Graham, MHM, will be coming to St Anthony’s to thank you all for your support and donations during the last year and to appeal for new Red Box holders.
