Some shocking statistics were published in the papers this summer regarding the number of children living in poverty in our region, and the figures for Hull alone were:

Hull West and Hessle:	7,090
Hull North:	8,682
Hull East:	7,718

Making a total of 23,490 children in Hull alone!

When this is added to the figures for Beverley, Holderness, East Yorkshire and Lincolnshire, the total for our region is 62,853.

With the help of St Anthony's Primary School we can help some of these children living locally, so, once again the SVP is appealing for gifts for children who are unlikely to receive anything this Christmas.
