SVP Christmas Gifts Appeal

Some shocking statistics were published in the papers this summer regarding the number of children living in poverty in our region, and the figures for Hull alone were:

Hull West and Hessle: 7,090

Hull North: 8,682

Hull East: 7,718 a total of 23,490 children in Hull alone!

When this is added to the figures for Beverley, Holderness, East Yorkshire and Lincolnshire, the total for our region is 62,853.

With the help of St Anthony's Primary School we can help some of these children living locally, so, once again the SVP is appealing for gifts for children who are unlikely to receive anything this Christmas. The list of children is longer than ever, and is on the table in the porch today, and will remain there until 8th December. Children's Liturgy

A reminder that the Children's Liturgy is intended for children who are aged four and over. Generally they continue to be a part of the group for one year after their First Holy Communion, and after this they should be ready to remain with their families during the Liturgy of the Word. Children should be confident enough to attend without a parent, although you are very welcome to take them in for the first time.
