### **Anthony Storey Memorial Lecture**

Tuesday 21st June at 7.30 pm. The speaker is Dr. Carmody Grey, Assistant Professor of Catholic Theology at Durham University, and in 2021 she was ‘Visiting Research Fellow’ at the Laudato Si Research Institute. Her topic is *‘Thinking about Faith and the Environment. What do we want to sustain?’*. Dr. Grey is an inspiring speaker, and in much demand for her lectures on science, nature and the environment. Her recent Hook Lecture was widely acclaimed, and she will be using the themes from this for the Storey Lecture. She teaches and speaks publicly in a variety of arenas, and is a columnist for The Tablet.
