## **Evangelii Gaudium Sunday - 18th September**

Today we celebrate Evangelii Gaudium Sunday, formerly known as Home Mission Sunday. It has been renamed after Pope Francis' Apostolic Exhortation of 2013 on the Joy of the Gospel.

The day supports the work carried out by the Mission Directorate at the Bishops' Conference by supporting our bishops in three important areas.

Firstly, evangelisation and catechesis.

Secondly, guided by the bishops, the beauty of the Liturgy and our church buildings. The Mission Directorate ensures that liturgical directives from Rome are acted upon and liturgical texts are translated into English.

Thirdly, sharing the beauty of the Catholic Faith with Christian and non-Christians through outreach and dialogue.

There will be a mandatory **Second Collection** after Mass.
