Advent Wreath Candles

During each Sunday of the Advent Season, we focus on one of the four virtues Jesus brings us: **Hope, Love, Joy** and **Peace**, three purple candles and one pink candle. On the First Sunday of Advent, the first purple candle is lit. This candle is typically called the 'Prophecy Candle' in remembrance of the prophets, primarily Isaiah, who foretold of the birth of Christ.

On the Second Sunday of Advent, the second purple candle is lit. This candle typically represents love. Some traditions call this the 'Bethlehem Candle', symbolising Christ's manger.

On the Third Sunday of Advent the pink, or rose-coloured, candle is lit. This pink candle is customarily called the 'Shepherds Candle', and it represents joy.

The fourth and last candle, often called the 'Angels Candle', represents peace and is lit on the Fourth Sunday of Advent.

The Lighting of the First Candle

These living flames will be a sign of hope, a light in the darkness of this anxious world, as we prepare for the coming of your Son, by turning away from selfishness and sin and renewing our faith in him.

Father in heaven,

the day draws near when the glory of your Son will take away the sadness of this waiting world.

May we not hold back from sharing the joy of all those who seek him.

May the darkness surrounding us not blind us to that wisdom and truth which fills the minds of all those who find him.

We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
