Saints of the week

St Agatha

St Agatha of Sicily was born in Catania, part of the Roman Province of Sicily, and was martyred c. 251. She is the patron saint of Malta, breast cancer patients, rape victims, martyrs and bakers.

St Paul Miki and Companions

St Paul Miki was a Japanese Jesuit who was martyred in 1597 along with 25 other clergy and laity. St Paul is the patron saint of Japan.

St Jerome Emiliani

St Jerome was an Italian humanitarian in the 16th century and founder of the Somaschi Fathers, although he himself remained a layman his whole life. He is the patron saint of orphans.

St Josephine Bakhita

St Josephine was a Sudanese-Italian Canossian religious sister who lived in Italy for 45 years in the early 20th century, after having been a slave in Sudan. She was canonized in 2000.

St Teilo

St Teilo, also known by his Cornish name Eliud, was a British Christian monk, bishop, and founder of monasteries and churches in the 6th century. He was from Penally near Tenby in Pembrokeshire, South Wales and he is the patron saint of Cardiff.

St Scholastica

St Scholastica was born in Italy, and a ninth-century tradition makes her the twin sister of Saint Benedict of Nursia. Scholastica is traditionally regarded as the founder of the Benedictine nuns.
