# Removal of the 50% Cap on new faith schools

The Department for Education is currently running a consultation on ending the 50% Cap on admissions for new free schools. This has been a longstanding objective of the Catholic Education Service since the changes were introduced in 2010. The consultation is running until 20<sup>th</sup> June and, notwithstanding the calling of the General Election for 4<sup>th</sup> July, it is essential that the DfE receives more positive responses than negative ones to have any chance of the Cap being removed in the future.
