## Preparing for Mass

## PRAY: The Assisted Suicide Bill in the House of Lords

The House of Lords is debating the Assisted Suicide (Leadbeater) Bill on 10 more Fridays. Those dates are most Fridays between 9th Jan and 27th March, plus 24th April. Please pray on those dates that the Peers in the House of Lords will hear the truth of its dangers.

PRAY also that they will have the courage to realise that no number of amendments can make the Bill “safe”, as those at risk are those with mental ill health, the elderly and disabled people.

PRAY they’ll throw it out completely (which they can do as it is only a Private Member’s Bill) and not be bullied into passing it.
